

ORDINANCE NO. 2023-02

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING **§71.06 TRUCK ROUTES., CHAPTER 71: TRAFFIC REGULATIONS IN TITLE VII: TRAFFIC CODE** OF THE VILLAGE CODE TO AMEND THE PROVISIONS THEREOF CONCERNING TRUCK ROUTES AND DESIGNATING CERTAIN STREETS AS TRUCK ROUTES IN THE VILLAGE; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRPERSON AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF HOSKINS, NEBRASKA TO AMEND **§71.06 TRUCK ROUTES., CHAPTER 71: TRAFFIC REGULATIONS** FOUND IN **TITLE VII: TRAFFIC CODE** OF THE VILLAGE CODE TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.

§71.06 TRUCK ROUTES.

(A) *General Authorization.* The Board of Trustees may, by Ordinance, designate certain streets within the corporate limits of the Village that trucks shall travel upon and it shall be unlawful for persons operating the trucks to travel on other streets than those designated for trucks, unless authorized hereunder.

(B) *Definition.* **Truck** shall mean a semi-tractor or semi-tractor and/or trailer, or a truck and/or truck and trailer, having a rated vehicle weight of more than 26,000 pounds (Class 7).

(C) *Specific Routes Designated.* The following streets within the Village are hereby designated as truck routes:

<u>Street</u>	<u>From</u>	<u>To</u>
Main Street	State Highway 35	Riverside Drive
East 2 nd Street	Main Street	East to Corporate limits
Washington Street	Main Street	Scale

(D) *Prohibited Operation.* It shall be unlawful for any person or entity to operate any truck rated Class 7 or above which requires a Class B license over any street, avenue, alley, or highway within the corporate limits of the Village of Hoskins, Nebraska that is not designated as a truck route.

(E) *Exceptions.*

(1) If the commercial point of origin or commercial designation for any truck herein defined shall be off such truck route, then such vehicle may proceed to and

from said commercial point of origin or commercial designation by the shortest route possible to and from the nearest truck route.

(2) A resident of the Village who operates a semi-tractor may proceed to and from a personal residence so long as the trailer is detached and so long as the semi-tractor proceeds to and from the personal residence by the shortest route possible to and from the nearest truck route.

(3) Trucks being utilized by or at the direction of the Village or the State of Nebraska when conducting road maintenance, snow removal, or responding to an emergency situation shall not be restricted to truck routes.

(F) *Signs.* The Village shall cause Notices to be posted and/or shall erect signs, indicating the streets so designated as truck routes.

(G) *Penalty.* Any person or entity violating any provision of this Section shall be subject to the penalties set forth in Section 71.99 Penalty and/or Section 10.99 Penalty of the Village Code.

Section 2. Any other Ordinance or Section passed or approved prior to the passage, approval, and publication or posting of this Ordinance or in any conflict with the Ordinance is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and shall be in full force from and after its passage, approval, publication or posting as required by law.
